In addition, Noam represents high profile clients in administrative legislation proceedings and litigation in different areas, including disputes related to tenders, environmental law regulations and litigation, constitutional litigation and other administrative issues.

### Recent notable examples of Noam's practice:

The litigation was successfully resolved in the General Department of the District Court.
- Representation of **Israel Railways, Israel's national railway company**, in a number of class-action lawsuits in the field of environmental protection, prevention of air-pollution and odor and smoke nuisance in the District Court and in the Supreme Court, which have concluded successfully.
- Representation of the **4 largest insurance companies and 4 largest insurance agencies in Israel** in a class-action lawsuit regarding the management of the pension funds of the largest employers in the Israeli economy. The litigation was concluded successfully in the Regional Court.
- Representation of **Osem, one of the largest food producers in Israel** (part of the Nestle group), in several class-actions lawsuits in the areas of regulation and consumerism, misleading advertising, misleading food labeling and related concerns in all levels of courts and in proceedings against the

- Consumer Protection and Fair Trade Authority.
- Representation of the Turkish electronics concern **Arcelic** in a lawsuit filed against it by the Israeli **Newpan** Group regarding the distribution of Bloomberg brand products in Israel.
  - Representation of **Abbott Laboratories** in a lawsuit filed by the **Teva company** regarding the distribution of the infant formula Similac in Israel.
  - Representation of the **Zero Waste company, part of the Shikyn & Binui Group**, in proceedings in the District Court and in the Supreme Court, regarding the NIS 3 billion BOT tender of the Ministry of Environmental Protection for the construction and operation of Israel's largest waste-treatment facility. The litigation has recently been successfully concluded.
  - Representation of and consulting the tenders committee of **Mekorot, the national water company of Israel**, in appeals against the decisions of the tenders committee before the District Court and the Supreme Court.
  - Representation of **Shikyn & Binui, Israel's leading infrastructure and real-estate company**, in administrative petitions relating to the establishment of the new intelligence campus in the Negev and in a tender for the establishment, design and construction of the new light-rail system in Jerusalem.

Additionally, Noam frequently lectures at various legal conferences and conventions and regularly participates in legal discussion panels.
