Pituach the Financing and Investment Trust v. Shapira et al.

News

Our firm successfully represented several heirs in an appeal filed with the Supreme Court against the ruling of the Central District Court. The appeal centered on the dismissal of a claim filed against our clients for the enforcement of a lease agreement dating back to the 1950s, signed between our clients' predecessors and the entrepreneurial arm of the Histadrut Labor Federation for the purpose of establishing a neighborhood for Orthodox Jews in Hod Hasharon. A counterclaim filed by our clients for the cancellation of the long-term lease agreement due to multiple breaches was approved. After our clients submitted a response to the appeal, and an oral hearing was held, the Supreme Court recommended that the appellant withdraw their appeal, and the appeal was dismissed. This marks a successful end to a complex legal process spanning over 7 years, involving various discussions in contractual law, real estate law, and statute of limitations.
